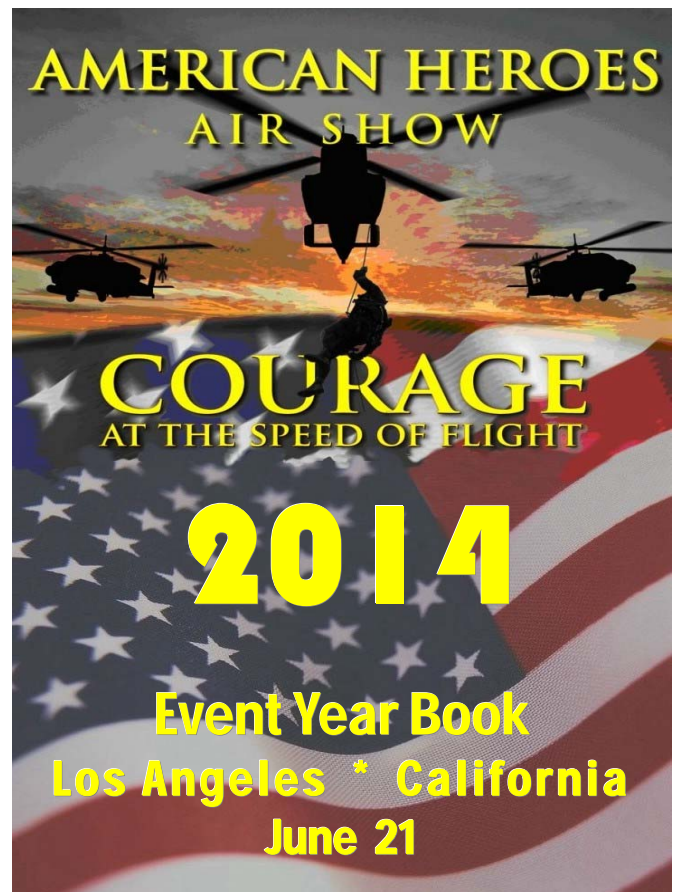

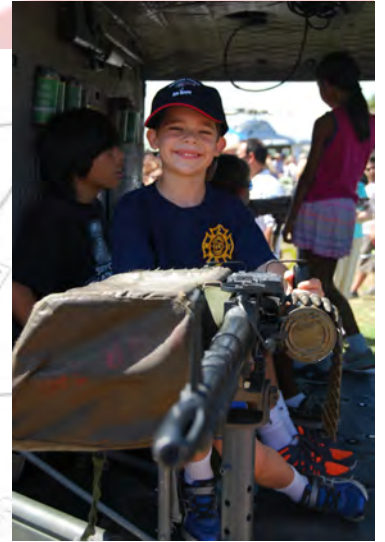

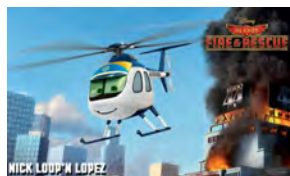

We enjoy a great turnout from local, regional, state and Federal organizations plus many volunteer Search & Rescue teams from the area.

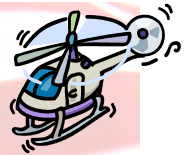

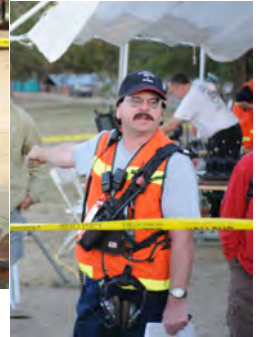

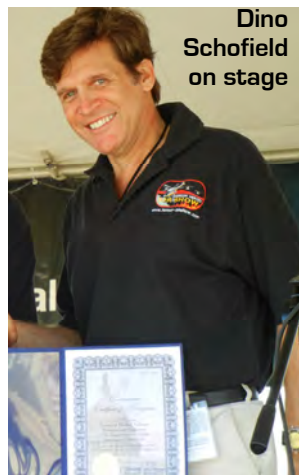
