We enjoy a great turnout from local, regional, state and Federal organizations plus many volunteer Search & Rescue teams from around Southern California.

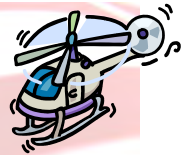

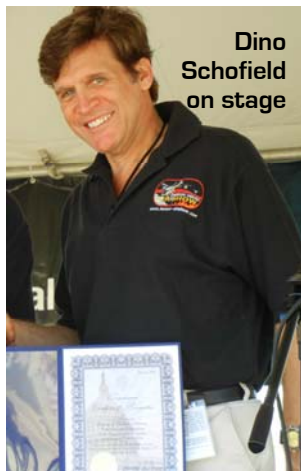

The American Heroes Air Show is produced in communities across the nation by volunteers with a passion for aviation, public safety & community service.

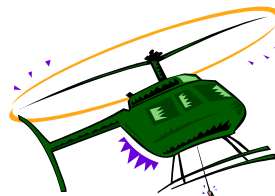
