- **AMERICAN Anthem Presentation** - introduce your family to our newest U.S. citizens when members of the U.S. military and others recite their Oath of Allegiance during an emotional Naturalization Ceremony in front of AVTT's replica of the Vietnam Memorial Wall.
- **CODE3 Career Expo** - recruiting teams are on-scene to profile careers in law enforcement, homeland security and national defense along with schools featuring information on their classes in Criminal Justice, Emergency Preparedness and Homeland Security.
- We're also proud to remind the community that it's never too late to recognize our military heroes when the **MISSING in AMERICA Project** searches out the cremated remains of U.S. military which have been abandoned and our event honors them during an emotional Memorial Service in front of the AVTT Wall.
- **Exciting military re-enactments** with vehicles and equipment from the **Texas Military Forces Museum** plus family activities, concessions & non-profit organizations that support Veterans, community preparedness and First Responder missions.

On Saturday we team up with **U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services** for a special Naturalization Ceremony as members of the U.S. military & the community stand up and become America's newest citizens!

Remind your family that it's never too late to honor America's Heroes by attending the **Missing In America Project's** special Memorial Service on Sunday morning. With the AVTT Wall as the emotional backdrop, this service will honor U.S. military members whose cremated remains were previously abandoned until the MIAP team identified and recovered them for suitable interment.
