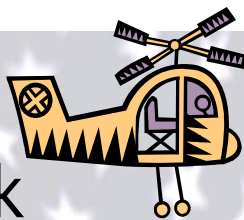


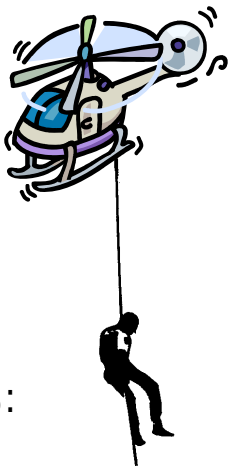

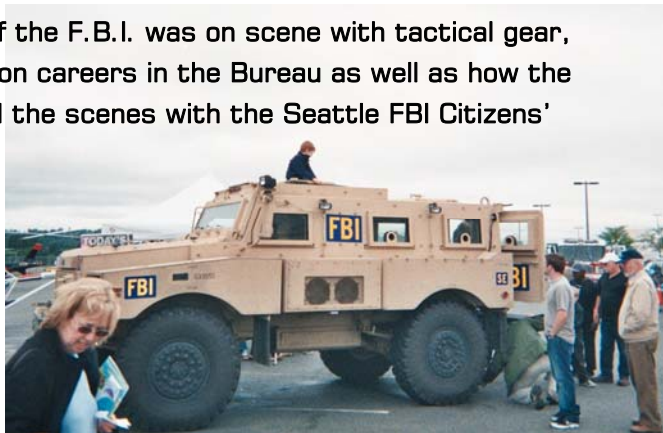
Our friends from the DEA aviation and recruiting teams are on-scene once again.

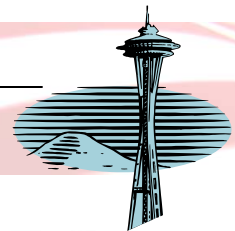
